	Listen to music from World War 1 and compose your own rhythmical movement through the use of an instrument or dance.
	Make a poster to remember Sergeant Stubby.
	Research information about the part that animals played in World War 1
	Make a model of the Christmas truce; the men playing football in no-man's land.
	Make your own World War 1 helmet, you could even put your own name and design on it.
	Make your own electric circuit – see if you can light a bulb using a potato.
