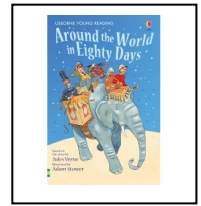


### Nurture 3 Autumn Term Homework Tasks

#### Instructions

1. Choose which homework tasks you would like to do. You should choose at least two. One to be completed before October half term and the other before the Christmas holidays.

	Create a collage of one country that Phileas Fogg visited on his journey. Annotate it to show the country's foods, visitor attractions, natural landmarks.
	Write a book review of Around the world in 80 Days. Discuss the author as well key points in the text.
	Draw a map of the world and mark on the map, the journey of Phileas Fogg and Passepartout.
	Research different flag for countries around the world. Draw any lines of symmetry on them.
	Make a steam train or ship out of junk modelling or Lego, illustrating one of the methods of transport that was used in the book.
	Make / bake something from World War 1.
	Watch the film 'Around the World in 80 Days' and write a film review. Discuss how it is the same as the novel and how it is different.
	Make a travel journal for Phileas Fogg's journey around the world. Include pictures and places to visit from each of the countries.
	Create a menu for a meal from one of the countries visited by Fogg and Passepartout. Try to cook / bake some of the items or serve them to your family and remember to take photos!
	Listen to music from an unusual country visited and compose your own rhythmical movement through the use of an instrument or dance.
	Imagine you are going on a trip around the world. What would you pack and why? If possible, collect examples of these things and place in a suitcase to show everyone.
