The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe.



Instructions

1. Choose which homework tasks you would like to do. You should choose at least two. One to be completed before February half term and the other before the Easter holidays.
2. Complete your homework tasks at home and then bring them in to school before the Homework Showcase event. If you can't bring them in to school, then take a photograph and share it with your teacher.

All of the homework tasks that have been completed will be shared with parents, staff and other pupils through a Homework Showcase event.

	Create a collage of Christmas in Narnia
	Watch the film and write a film review of The Lion, The Witch and The wardrobe. What did you enjoy?
	Find or make a net to make a box for Edmunds Turkish delight
	Draw a map of Narnia, you can use existing maps or make one from your imagination. Draw in the important features such as Lantern, the stone table and the White Witch's castle
	Mr Tumnus was half faun and half man. Create 4 fantastical creatures that could have existed in Narnia. Remember to label all their adaptations!
	Design a colourful poster for the film The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe.
	Design and make a magical winter world out of junk modelling materials
	Create a menu for a meal using foods that you might find in World War 2. Try to cook / bake some of the items and bring them in or take a picture of your family eating them.
	Listen to music from World War 2 and compose your own rhythmical movement through the use of an instrument or dance.
	Research information about the evacuation of children in World War 2 and imagine that you had been evacuated. Write a letter or postcard home explaining your feelings.
	Create some beautiful snowflakes out of white paper and glitter. Remember each one is unique!

	Use what you have learnt about changes of state in Science to make a desert. This could involve melting chocolate to make crispie cakes or freezing to make ice-cream.
	Using your learning from Science, create a device that demonstrates an energy transfer and label the energy going in and the energ(ies) going out.
	Make an orrery (model) of the Solar System.
	Create a set of fact cards about the components that make up our Solar System.
