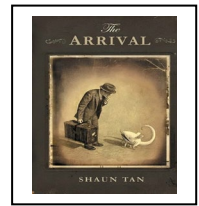


## Year 9 Spring Term Learning Extension Tasks

#### Instructions

1. Choose which homework tasks you would like to do. You should choose at least two. One to be completed before October half term and the other before the Christmas holidays.
2. Complete your homework tasks at home and then bring them in to school before the Homework Showcase event. If you can't bring them in to school, then take a photograph and share it with your teacher.

All of the homework tasks that have been completed will be shared with parents, staff and other pupils through a Homework Showcase event.

Task(s) I have chosen (√)	Homework Tasks
	Provide a synopsis of the story. What are the main events that happen, in order? What does the main character do? Who does he meet along the way?
	Produce a written piece of work to explain what the central conflict in the story is. How does the main character deal with this conflict? What challenges or obstacles does he face? How does he deal with them?
	Write a newspaper report about a significant event during Second World War
	Make a model 3D scene from the war.
	Research your family tree and find out which family members were alive in WW2. Can you find out anything else about them? Did any of them serve in the army?
	Design and make an air raid/Anderson shelter- which materials will you use? Produce a written explanation of your design and an evaluation of your model.
	Rationing was difficult. You only have £5 to spend for a week's food shopping. Use <a href="http://www.asda.com">www.asda.com</a> to decide what you would buy. It has to last all week! Explain what you chose and why you chose it.
	Draw a map of a journey you have made, remember to add details such as street names and landmarks. You could include a key too
	Create a self-portrait in a frame using different art materials at home – try using sepia tones similar to the book.
	Design a fact sheet on your own new mythical creature that would fit in with everyday life: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Big or small?</li> <li>• Where does it live?</li> <li>• What purpose does it serve?</li> </ul>
	Describe an important journey that you have taken in your life.
