	CREATIVE - Design and make a Chinese mask or make a junk model Chinese dragon to celebrate Chinese New Year.
	CREATIVE – Have a meal in a Chinese restaurant with your family or order a Chinese takeaway- bring in the menu and take photos.
	CREATIVE – We have been reading “The Magic Paintbrush” in school, can you create your own painting of something you would like to come alive?
	ENGLISH – Write/mark-make your full name in Cantonese and write and practice how to say hello in Cantonese
	ENGLISH – Write a folk tale in the style of The Magic Paintbrush which has a strong and easily identifiable moral
	HUMANITIES – Draw a map of China and mark on the main cities and main tourist attractions found in the country.
	HUMANITIES – Create a brochure to attract people to visit China. Make sure you include some interesting things to see and do whilst visiting China!
	SCIENCE – The Great Wall of China can be seen from Space. Can you research any other structures that can be seen from Space and design a leaflet that explain these?
	SCIENCE – China has developed bullet trains designed for speeds up to 217 miles per hour. Research what speed means and which animals are the fastest on land and in the sea. Why are the trains able to go so much faster than animals?
