Task(s) I have chosen (√)	Tasks
	Create a collage of Christmas in Narnia
	Watch a film of The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe and write a film review. What did you enjoy?
	Mr Tumnus was half fawn and half man. Create your own fantastical creature that could have existed in Narnia. Remember to label all the adaptations!
	Design a colourful poster advertising the film of the Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe
	Design and make a magical winter scene from junk modelling materials
	Create a menu for a meal using foods that you might find in WW2. Try to cook/bake some of the items and bring them in or take a picture of your family enjoying them!
	Listen to some music from WW2 and compose your own rhythmical movement through the use of an instrument or dance
	Research information about the evacuation of children in WW2 and imagine this had happened to you. Write a letter or postcard home explaining your feelings
	Create some beautiful snowflakes out of white paper and glitter. Remember each one must be unique!
	Find out information about the 4 seasons. Make an information booklet about the different weather, plants and holidays that are in each of the seasons.
	Design a map of the land of Narnia. Make sure you add the locations of each of the important parts of the story eg Cair Paravel, The Lamppost, The Beavers house , the stone table etc
